

V for Victory Crochet Scarf

Materials: I and J hook, 2 skeins (6 ozs./394 yards) Lion Brand Wool-Ease Ranch Red yarn

Possible color substitutes: Colors that can be worn by either gender such as red, white and blue, dark greens, tans, browns, greys, and fisherman. No pinks or pastels.

Size: approx. 7" x 60"

Pattern Abbreviations:

ch—chain

dc—double crochet

sk—skip

st(s)-stitch(es)

sl st—slip stitch

Notes:

Ch 2, turn on every row. (If you prefer, you can use ch-3 to for your turning chain). Turning chain counts as dc throughout and is included in beginning count.

There will be 23 stitches on every row counting dc and ch stitches

Each "V" will be made with a hook one size larger because the holes tend to draw in the stitches and make that section slightly narrower.

With I hook, chain 25

Row 1: dc in 4th chain from hook and each ch across (23 dc)

Row 2: dc in each dc across, turn

Change to J Hook

Beginning of V:

Row 3: 10 dc, ch 3, sk 3, 10 dc

Row 4: 9 dc, ch 2, sk 1 dc and 1 ch, dc in next ch, *(note: If you prefer, on this and all rows, you can go into the chain space rather than into the chain. The reason I suggest going into the chain itself is because I find it keeps the stitches closer together.)*, ch 2, sk next ch and next dc, 9 dc

Row 5: 8 dc, ch2, sk 1 dc and 1 ch, dc in next ch, dc in next dc, dc in next ch, ch 2, sk next ch and next dc, 8 dc



Row 6: 7 dc, ch 2, sk 1 dc and 1 ch, dc in next ch, dc in next 3 dc, dc in next ch, ch 2, sk next ch and next dc, 7 dc

Row 7: 6 dc, ch 2, sk 1 dc and 1 ch, dc in next ch, dc in next 5 dc, dc in next ch, ch 2, sk next ch and next dc, 6 dc

Row 8: 5 dc, ch 2, sk 1 dc and 1 ch, dc in next ch, dc in next 7 dc, dc in next ch, ch 2, sk next ch and next dc, 5 dc

Row 9: 4 dc, ch 2, sk 1 dc and 1 ch, dc in next ch, dc in next 9 dc, dc in next ch, ch 2, sk next ch and next dc, 4 dc

Row 10: 3 dc, ch 2, sk 1 dc and 1 ch, dc in next ch, dc in next 11 dc, dc in next ch, ch 2, sk next ch and next dc, 3 dc

Row 11: 2 dc, ch 4, skip next 4 sts (*that would be the next dc, 2 chains, and dc*), dc in next 11 dc, ch 4, skip next 4 sts, 2 dc

Change to I Hook

Row 12: 2 dc, 4 dc in ch-4 sp, dc in ea of next 11 dc, 4 dc in ch-4 sp, 2 dc (23 dc)
At this point your length should be between 6 and 6 1/2".

Row 13 to 100: dc across row (23 dc)

You can work more rows if you want a longer scarf, but remember to buy more yarn.

Reverse V:

Change to J Hook

Note: Remember you will have 23 sts on each row, counting dc and chains; also remember to ch-2 or ch-3 and turn at the end of each row. The turning ch counts as a stitch.

Row 101: 2 dc, ch 4, sk 4 dc, dc in ea of next 11 dc, ch 4, sk 4 dc, 2 dc

Row 102: 2 dc, dc in ch, ch 2, sk 2 ch, dc in next ch, dc in next 11 dc, dc in ch, ch 2, sk 2 ch, dc in next ch, dc in last 2 sts

Row 103: 3 dc, dc in ch, ch 2, sk ch, sk dc, dc in next 11 dc, ch 2, sk dc, sk ch, dc in next ch, dc in last 3 sts

Row 104: 4 dc, dc in ch, ch 2, sk next ch, sk dc, dc in next 9 dc, ch 2, sk dc, sk ch, dc in next ch, dc in last 4 sts

Row 105: 5 dc, dc in ch, ch 2, sk ch, sk dc, dc in next 7 dc, ch 2, sk dc, sk ch, dc in next ch, dc in last 5 sts

Row 106: 6 dc, dc in ch, ch 2, sk ch, sk dc, dc in next 5 dc, ch 2, sk dc, sk ch, dc in next ch, dc in last 6 sts

Row 107: 7 dc, dc in ch, ch 2, sk ch, sk dc, dc in next 3 dc, ch 2, sk dc, sk ch, dc in next ch, dc in last 7 sts

Row 108: 8 dc, dc in ch, ch 2, sk ch, sk dc, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk dc, sk ch, dc in ch, dc in last 8 sts

Row 109: 9 dc, dc in ch, ch 3, sk next (ch, dc, ch), dc in next ch, dc in last 9 sts

Change to I hook

Row 110: 10 dc, 3 dc in ch-3 sp, 10 dc (23 dc)

Row 111: dc across

You will finish on the right side of work. Continue with Edging.

Edging: ch 1, continuing on right side, sc around. In corners choose the option below which keeps your corner flat.

Corner Options:

A - 3 sc in each corner

B - (sc, ch 1, sc)

C - (sc, ch 2, sc)

D - (2 sc, ch 2, 2 sc)

E - (2 sc, ch 1, 2 sc)

F - (sc, hdc, sc)

G - (sc, ch 1, sc, ch 1, sc)
