### Materials:

original: Crochet Hook size G; 100% Merino Irrestringibile worsted weight yarn

**Revisions:** H hook, 7 ozs Red Heart Super Saver Light Sage or other worsted weight yarn)

**Size** (in RHSS w/H hk): 7" x 62"

*Note: ch 2, turn on every row; ch 2 counts as dc throughout and is included in beginning and ending dc count); there will be 23 stitches on every row counting dc and ch stitches*

Chain: 25 (Tip- use a hook slightly larger (approx. size H) to do initial chain, this will keep it from curling.) (from Sandie – I personally sometimes need to use a size smaller hook to do the initial chain. Sometimes I need a larger or the same size. Use what works best for you for the particular project.)

Row 1: dc in 4th chain from hook and each remaining ch. DC 23

Row 2: dc in each dc across (dc 23)

### For V:

Row 3: 10 dc, ch 3, sk 3, 10 dc

Row 4: 9 dc, ch 2, sk 1 dc and 1ch, dc in next ch, ch 2, sk next ch and next dc, 9 dc

Row 5: 8 dc, ch2, sk 1 dc and 1 ch, dc in next ch, dc in next dc, dc in next ch, ch 2, sk next ch and next dc, 8 dc

Row 6: 7 dc, ch 2, sk 1 dc and 1 ch, dc in next ch, dc in next 3 dc, dc in next ch, ch 2, sk next ch and next dc, 7 dc

Row 7: 6 dc, ch 2, sk 1 dc and 1 ch, dc in next ch, dc in next 5 dc, dc in next ch, ch 2, sk next ch and next dc, 6 dc

Row 8: 5 dc, ch 2, sk 1 dc and 1 ch, dc in next ch, dc in next 7 dc, dc in next ch, ch 2, sk next ch and next dc, 5 dc



Row 9: 4 dc, ch 2, sk 1 dc and 1 ch, dc in next ch, dc in next 9 dc, dc in next ch, ch 2, sk next ch and next dc, 4 dc

Row 10: 3 dc, ch 3, sk 1 dc and 1 ch, dc in next ch, dc in next 11 dc, dc in next ch, ch 3, sk next ch and next dc, 3 dc

Row 11: 2 dc, ch 4, skip next 5 sts, dc in next 11 dc, ch 4, skip next 5 sts, 2 dc

Row 12 : 2 dc, 4 dc in ch-4 sp, dc in ea of next 11 dc, 4 dc in ch-4 sp, 2 dc (23 dc)

Row 13 to 104 or to desired length: dc across row (23 dc)

**Reverse V:**

Row 105: 2 dc, ch 4, sk 4 dc, dc in ea of next 11 dc, ch 4, sk 4 dc, 2 dc (23 sts)

Row 106: 2 dc, dc in ch, ch 2, sk 2 ch, dc in next ch, dc in next 11 dc, dc in ch, ch 2, sk 2, dc in ch, 2 dc

Row 107: 3 dc, dc in ch, ch 2, sk ch, sk dc, dc in next 11 dc, ch 2, sk dc, sk ch, dc in ch, 3 dc

Rnd 108: 4 dc, dc in ch, ch 2, sk ch, sk dc, dc in next 9 dc, ch 2, sk 2, sk ch, dc in ch, 4 dc

Rnd 109: 5 dc, dc in ch, ch 2, sk ch, sk dc, dc in next 7 dc, ch 2, sk dc, sk ch, dc in ch, 5 dc

Rnd 110: 6 dc, dc in ch, ch 2, sk ch, sk dc, dc in next 5 dc, ch 2, sk dc, sk ch, dc in ch, 6 dc

Rnd 111: 7 dc, dc in ch, ch 2, sk ch, sk dc, dc in next 3 dc, ch 2, sk dc, sk ch, dc in ch, 7 dc

Rnd 112: 8 dc, dc in ch, ch 2, sk ch, sk dc, dc in next dc, ch 2, sk dc, sk ch, dc in ch, 8 dc

Rnd 113: 9 dc, dc in ch, ch 3, sk ch, sk dc, sk ch, dc in ch, 9 dc

Rnd 114: 10 dc, 3 dc in ch-3 sp, 10 dc (23 dc)

Rnd 115: dc across (23 dc)

Border: on right side, sc around working (sc, ch 2, sc) in corners.
