

## Sarah Waits

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Materials: H hook, #16 needle, small amount  
worsted weight yarn in three colors

Color A –white  
Color B— red  
Color C—green

Size: 6"

### Abbreviations

ch = chain      lsc = long single crochet  
ea = each      rnd = round  
hk = hook      sc = single crochet

### Special stitches:

long single crochet (lsc) - Insert hook on the row  
below the row you are working on, and work a sc,  
bringing your loop up to same height as previous  
stitches

Note: Change color by completing last sc of row in  
new color

Multiple: even number

With Color A ch 18

Row 1: single crochet in 2nd chain from hook and in  
each chain across, ch 1, turn

Row 2: sc in each sc, change to Color B, ch 1, turn

Row 3: long single crochet (lsc) in first stitch on

second row below (in other words, not in the first  
stitch of this row, but go in front of the stitch to the  
hole below it), \* sc in next stitch, lsc in next (on row  
below), repeat from \* across row. You will end with a  
lsc in last stitch (on row below) , ch 1, turn.

Row 4: sc in ea st across, change to Color A, ch 1,  
turn,

Row 5: sc in first sc, \*lsc in next, sc in next, repeat  
from \* across. You will end with a sc in the last  
stitch, ch 1, turn.

Row 6: sc in ea st across, change to Color B, ch 1,  
turn

Rows 7-24: Repeat rows 3-6, working two rows of  
each color. Finish off. (You should have 5 1/2" at this  
point.)

### Border:

Join Color C in any corner, sc around entire square,  
working 3 sc in each corner. Note: You can  
substitute (sc, ch 2, sc) if corners if you like.

Finish off. Sew in ends.
