

Doctor Who Scarf Baby Afghan (worked in strips)
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This baby afghan was designed referencing Gene Fender's patterns at doctorwhoscarf.com. Adapted with permission.

The strips are intended to have a color flow as in the original scarf so correct placement is essential.



Materials: G hook

Since I worked up this pattern, Gene at doctorwhoscarf.com has come up with DK acrylic colors (listed below). Picture above uses a few different colors.

BBC = new colors (UK Colors from Deramores)

Purple = Knit Picks Brava Sport Currant, alternate Stylecraft Special DK Burgundy

Camel = Knit Picks Brava Sport Almond, alternate Stylecraft Special DK Camel

Mustard = Sirdar Hayfield Bonus DK Pumpkin

Rust = Knit Picks Brava Sport Paprika, alternate Stylecraft Special DK Copper

Grey = Stylecraft Special DK Graphite, alternate Knit Picks Brave Sport Cobblestone Heather

Greenish Brown = Sirdar Hayfield Bonus DK Moss Green, alternate Stylecraft Special DK Khaki

Bronze = Knit Picks Brava Sport Brindle, alternate King Cole Big Value DK Taupe

Size: each strip is about 8" wide, finished afghan 26" x 38" (for a wider afghan, work a larger foundation chain for each strip)

Instructions:

With G hook and burgundy, ch 36

Row 1: single crochet in 2nd chain from hook, single crochet in each chain across (35 sc)

Rows 2 – 522: chain 1, turn, single crochet across following row and color specifications below. I like to use a highlighter to mark each color stripe as I finish it.

*Read columns top to bottom, left to right
(number of rows – color)*

Column 1

4 - burgundy
26 - camel
8 - brindle
5 - pumpkin
11 - copper
4 - burgundy
22 - graphite
11 - khaki
4 - pumpkin
15 - camel
8 - copper
4 - brindle
6 - burgundy
22 - khaki
5 - pumpkin
9 - Graphite
5 - copper
5 - camel

End first column 174 rows

Column 2

9 - graphite
6 - brindle
22 - camel
4 - burgundy
11 - khaki
8 - pumpkin
21 - copper
4 - graphite
6 - camel
20 - brindle
4 - burgundy

10 - copper
4 - pumpkin
7 - graphite
11 - khaki
5 - burgundy
22 - camel

End of second column 174 rows

Column 3

2 - graphite
4 - copper
7 - burgundy
4 - camel
8 - pumpkin
28 - khaki
8 - copper
7 - graphite
5 - pumpkin
10 - brindle
5 - burgundy
6 - camel
18 - graphite
4 - copper
7 - pumpkin
8 - camel
4 - burgundy
16 - brindle
5 - copper
18 - burgundy

End of third column 174 rows

Finish off.

Border:

Edge each strip in burgundy working single crochet around. For corners work 3 single crochets in each corner or use your favorite corner which allows work to lie flat.

Join strips with a whipstitch, being careful of the order and making sure each strip is right side up and top and bottom in correct positions. This is important to keep the flow of the scarf pattern.

When the three strips are joined, work edging all around of (single crochet, chain 2, 2 double crochets, skip 2) in same stitch.
